Through our adoption process, **254 pigs were placed into loving, homes**. Each placement represents not just a successful adoption, but a life changed—one where pigs are valued, protected, and given the care they deserve.

Our work extended far beyond individual adoptions. Eastern Snouts proudly collaborated with **countless shelters and rescues across the country**, stepping in to provide support where resources were stretched thin and options were limited. By working together, we strengthened outcomes for pigs and the organizations fighting for them every day.



Highlights

This year, Eastern Snouts provided critical assistance in the following areas:


- **83 spay and neuter surgeries**, helping prevent overpopulation and life-threatening reproductive conditions
- **49 medical cases**, ensuring pigs received timely and necessary veterinary care
- **31 transport needs**, safely moving pigs to rescues, fosters, and adopters
- **17 pen, feed, and shelter support cases**, improving daily living conditions
- **13 hoof trims**, addressing an often-overlooked but essential aspect of pig health



Vital Funding

Money Raised: \$103,228.42

We generated vital funding through **auctions, Patreon, Bonfire merchandise, and general donations**, each contribution directly fueling lifesaving work and emergency response.



Looking Forward

Our goals for 2026 include:

- **Expanding our Rehome Coordinator team** to guide adopters, manage placement timelines, and ensure thoughtful, successful matches for pigs in need
- **Increasing the number of pigs placed into safe, permanent homes** through an efficient, compassionate adoption process
- **Strengthening rescue partnerships nationwide** by offering consistent rehoming support and placement assistance
- **Pursuing grant opportunities** to build sustainable funding and expand our lifesaving programs

By growing our Rehome Coordinator team, Eastern Snouts will be able to respond to more urgent cases, reduce time spent in temporary care, and ensure every pig's transition into a forever home is supported with care and intention.

With the dedication of our volunteers and the continued support of our community, 2026 holds the promise of **even greater impact, stronger collaboration, and more lives saved.**
